TLC Full Day/Adventure Only Enrollment Facts

It's easy to enroll your students in *The Learning Choice Academy's Full Day and Adventure Only Classes!*

- 1. Choose a Location.** Be sure to check out what is offered at each site (They vary slightly in content and are held on different days). Class schedules are available online at www.learningchoice.org.
- 2. Confirm that the class takes place at a time that will work with your schedule.** Because students must be dropped off and picked up promptly, please check to ensure that you will be able to accommodate this need. Some families have arranged carpooling to help with this situation and that is always an option for you.
- 3. Confirm that the fee for the chosen course will not conflict with other classes your student may already be taking through TLC's Extended Options payment program.** Enrolling in the Full Day class costs 70 units a month; enrolling in Adventure Only program costs 60 units a month. You may, of course, continue to have your students participate in other classes, but you may need to pay for these other classes out-of-pocket if you have exceeded the allotted 70 a month. Units for Spring semester will be deducted from March to June.
- 4. Fill out the Full Day/Adventure Only Registration form.** Be sure not only to give us the student's name, but also the grade level grouping in which he/she will be participating *and* the location at which the class will be held. Please also indicate whether your student will be attending Full Day or Adventure Only.

Please note: Once a student is enrolled in this program, it is assumed that he or she will participate in the program for the length of the semester. Students may attend the first day and then drop (although they will be charged 50 units), but students don't drop until after the second class are enrolled in the class for the entire semester and funds will be subtracted each month for the class.

- 5. Return the Registration form via mail, fax or in person to your local resource center.** Your Instructional Assistant will date mark the registration form and pass it on to the main office in La Mesa for processing.

Enrollment Timeline

Registration papers for classes go out with the newsletter. They may be returned in person, by fax or mail to a local resource center starting

Tuesday, January 10, 2012 at 8 am. *Prior applications are not accepted.*

Registrations for new Full Day and Adventure Only students will be processed in the order received beginning **Tuesday, January 10**. Registrations for Core Only and Adventure Only students will be processed after registrations for students who are attending an entire day of classes. Educational Partners will be notified that students have been officially enrolled in Full Day and Adventure Only courses. Families can find out whether or not they are enrolled in Full Day by calling their EP or looking at the physical list posted at each site starting on **Tuesday, January 24**.

Please note important Fall Full Day Dates:

January 30 – Classes begin.

February 27-March 2 – No Classes, Staff Development Conference

April 2-13 – No Classes, Spring Break

April 16-May 4 – No Classes, STAR Testing and Teacher Development

June 1– Classes end.
